All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Washington Avenue, and being Lots Nos. 8 and 9 on a Plat entitled "Proposed Resubdivision Old Looper-Yown Property" dated February 28, 1922, by Garrette and Dill, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "F", at page 48 said lots having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Washington Avenue (formerly White Horse Road) at the joint front corner of Lots No. 7 and 8 and running thence along the joint line of said lots S. 69-00 W. 350 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence N. 21-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 69-00 E. 350 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Washington Avenue; thence along said Avenue S. 21-30 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
