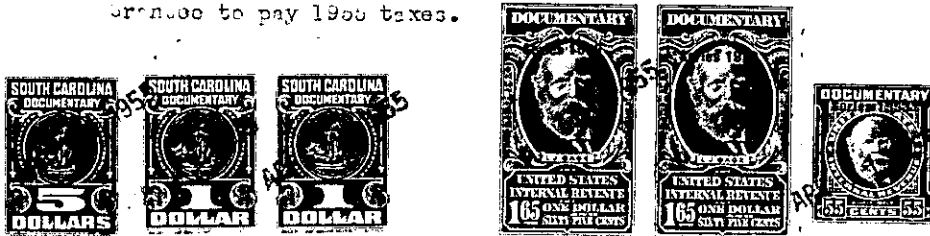

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 91, according to Plat of Section I of Lake Forest, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "GG", page 17, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastly side of Lake Fairfield Drive, joint front corner Lots 91 and 92, and running thence S. 24-13 E. 208.2 feet to a point where the joint line of Lots 91 and 92 intersects with the high water line of Lake Fairfield; thence along the high water line of Lake Fairfield, the traverse line being N. 11-33 E. 182.1 feet to a point where the joint line of Lots 90 and 91 intersects the high water line of Lake Fairfield; thence N. 03-04 W. 202 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastly side of Lake Fairfield Drive, thence along Lake Fairfield Drive S. 61-28 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
