CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

JAMES P. ROSAMOND, 106 Darlington Avenue, Sans Souci, Greenville, S. C.

and

ROBERT L. STODDARD, 601 Rutledge, Spartanburg, S. C.

did, on the 2nd. day of April, 19 55, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GENERAL BROKERAGE COMPANY, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.
(106 Darlington Ave., SansSouci)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to grow, buy and sell, or to grow, buy or sell on brokerage basis fruits and vegetables of all types. To furnish trucking service on brokerage basis. To buy and operate truck equipment for hauling fresh fruits and vegetables or other products. To enter into contracts with produce growers and to grow and produce and any other activities incidental to or necessary in the growing, purchasing and selling of produce.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of Fifty (\$50.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 31st. day of March, 19 55, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

James P. Rosamond and Robert L. Stoddard

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, James P. Rosamond ; as Vice-President, ; as Secretary, Robert L. Stoddard ; as Treasurer, Robert L. Stoddard

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
