RELEASE AND BILL OF SALE

WHEREAS, Dorothy Eugenia Rivers and James F. Rivers are husband and wife, and have been living separate and apart since January 19, 1954; and

WHEREAS, By proceedings dated January 19, 1955, said Dorothy Eugenia Rivers brought a suit for divorce from the said James F. Rivers who filed an Answer, through his attorney, Herman E. Cox, setting up a claim that the said Dorothy Eugenia Rivers was in possession of certain cash and personal property in which he claimed an interest; and

WHEREAS, Said parties have agreed to settle and end said claim, which claim was and is denied by the said Dorothy Eugenia Rivers and no admission of liability is made by the execution of this instrument. Now, therefore, it is

AGREED: That for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars in hand paid to the said James F. Rivers, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said James F. Rivers does hereby release, relinquish and forever discharge the said Dorothy Eugenia Rivers from any and all claims or demands of whatsoever kind or nature, and does hereby bargain, sell and transfer unto the said Dorothy Eugenia Rivers any and all interest he may have in any cash, bank account, savings and loan account and any and all other personal property of whatever kind or nature now in possession of the said Dorothy Eugenia Rivers and in which the said James F. Rivers has any claim. It is further agreed that the said James F. Rivers, as a part of this agreement, is to this day assign his interest to Dorothy Eugenia Rivers in a four grave lot situate in Woodlawn Memorial Park, being designated as Lot No. 27, Section A.
