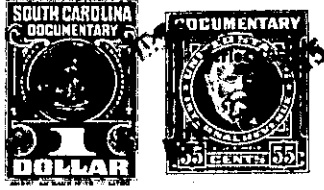

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bates Aiken, his  
Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 23  
in Block "G" as per plat of Woodville Heights made by W.J. Riddle,  
December, 1940 and recorded in plat book "L" at page 14 and 15  
R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly  
described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point at the intersection of Pine and  
Alice Sts. and running thence with the western side of  
Alice St. S. 3.00 W. 228.2 feet to joint corner of Lots  
No. 22 and 23; thence along the Northeastern side of  
Lot No. 22 N. 63.40 W. 127.6 Feet to an iron pin on the
