Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Charles B. Garren, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s)

Arthur Johnson, his Heirs and Assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Butler Township, about five miles east from Greenville, lying east from the Old Spartanburg Road, being a triangle in shape and lying on the south side of a tract conveyed by me to the grantee herein during the year 1954, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an old iron pin corner, said corner being S. 32-30 E. 225 feet from the said Old Spartanburg Road, and runs thence with the south line of the said plot conveyed to the grantee herein during 1954, S. 74-15 E. 1024 feet to a stake on the former Lee Burns line; thence with this line S. 44-40 W. 114.5 feet to an iron pin on the said line, new corner; thence N. 68-21 W. 974 feet to the beginning corner, containing One and Seventeen One-hundredths (1.17) acres, more or less.

In the deed of 1954 it was my intention to convey to the said Arthur Johnson a ten Acre (10) tract, but in the said deed I conveyed only 8.83 acres. In order to correct the error, I am making this deed so that there will be Ten (10) acres in the Arthur Johnson tract.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
