King, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of <sup>Fifteen</sup> / Thousand and No/100 (15,000.00) Dollars, to the grantors in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantors (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JOHN B. LEAGUE, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL OUR RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Chick Springs Township, being situate on the Southern side of U. S. Highway No. 29 (the Super Highway), and being more particularly described according to survey and plat of Dalton & Neves, March, 1946, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of the right-of-way of said highway, which is the Northeast corner of property of the State as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book Y at Page 50, and running thence with property of the Greer Nursery S. 30-19 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence with other property of the grantors S. 66-14 E. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence still with other property of the grantors N. 29-29 E. 225.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of said highway; thence with the Southern side of the right-of-way of said highway N. 66-14 E. 57.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said right-of-way S. 23-46 E. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said right-of-way N. 66-14 E. 242.5 feet to the beginning.
