

It is my intention to give my attorney the same power that I myself have over the management of my incoming and my outgoing money, whether in cash or whether represented by commercial paper.

My said attorney shall also have full and complete power to sell the whole of my real estate or any part thereof and to execute for and on my behalf good warranty deeds conveying the property to the purchaser in fee simple. My trustee shall be the sole judge as to the price to be charged for the property and for the proper use and handling of the proceeds derived from the sale thereof.

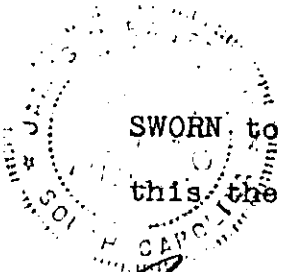
