

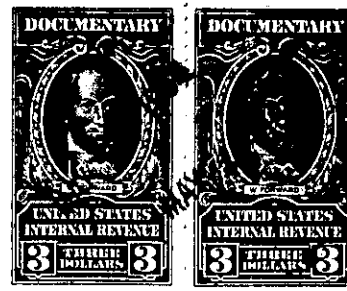
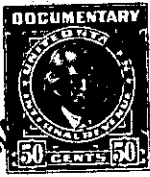

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, School District 4-C, near Golden Grove,
containing one (1) acre, more or less, and having the following
rates and bounds, to wit;

BEING 170 ft on an iron pin on the west side of Highway No. 29, at a
point 18 1/2 feet northeast of Fred Tumlin's corner, and running thence
