KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Frank A. Richerson and
Lillie M. Richerson

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00)
Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Greenville County

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville County

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina lying and situato near Tindal Road, in a subdivi-
sion known as Glynhaven Court and designated as the greater portion
of Glenmore Drive on a plat of the subdivision made by J. Mac Richard-
son, dated April 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book _____, Page _____ and being more particularly de-
scribed as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Earle Hunter Jr. line which pin is
S. 76-15 W. 61.2 feet from the center of Tindal Road and running thence
S. 76-15 W. 86.3 feet to an iron pin ; thence along a curve with a
radius of 72.53 feet S. 81-49 W. 13.7 feet to an iron pin at the
joint corner of lots numbers 1 and 2; thence still on the curve N. 79--
14 W. 34 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65-36 W. 296 feet to an iron
pin; thence along a curve with a radius of fifty feet a distance of
36 feet (the chord of which is S. 76-18 W. 35.2) to an iron pin, the
corner of lots numbers 6 and 7; thence still on a curve of a 50 foot
radius 67.6 feet (the chord of which is N. 45-02 W. 62.6 feet) to an
iron pin; thence N. 65-36 W. 7.3 feet to iron pin on the Epps property
line; thence with the Epps line N. 25-34 E. 50.0 to an iron pin; thence
