All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing .069 acre, more or less, and having according to a plat prepared by J. C. Hill dated November 6, 1954, entitled "Property of Wallace E. Dean" the following metes and bounds:
