That I, M. W. Fore in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred fifty and no/100 (\$550.00) DOLLARS,

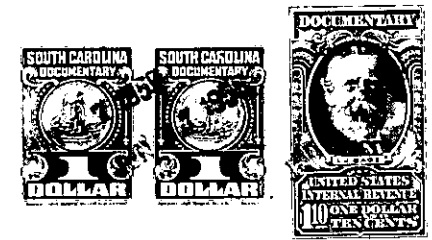
