

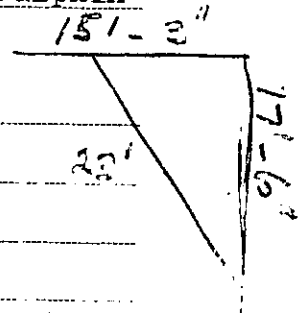

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy-five and 00/100 ----- DOLLARS

to it in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents, by James B. and Lottie W. Galphin (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James B. and Lottie W. Galphin

Lot No. 167-Q of Springwood Cemetery, having the following dimensions, to-wit:  
North 15-1/4 feet, East 17-1/2 feet, Southwest 23 feet



for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said Cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

The grantor further acknowledges receipt of --NONE-- Dollars for the perpetual upkeep and care of said cemetery lot by the grantor, its successors and assigns.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Hereditaments and Appurtenances of said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Hand and to Hold all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said James B. and Lottie W. Galphin, their heirs and assigns forever; subject, however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.

And it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said grantee his, her, or their Heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors and assigns, and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any party thereof.
