That I, Arthur J. R. Moore

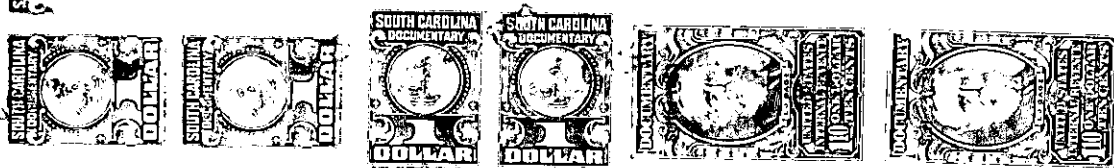
