

WHEREAS, under an Act of the General Assembly of South Carolina, duly passed and effective upon approval by the Governor on April 21, 1954, 48 Statutes at Large 855, reported in 1954 Acts of the General Assembly, page 2215, the Gantt Water and Sewer District was created and authorized to furnish water, sewer and garbage service and fire protection to the area within the District and was further authorized to prescribe regulations requiring residents of the District to make use of the water system provided by the District.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Gantt Water and Sewer District hereby adopts the following regulations relating to the required use of water by residents of the District:

1. All residents of the District shall be connected to the water transmission and distribution lines of the District within sixty (60) days after being notified by the Commission that water can and will be furnished to that specified residential unit within the District area.
2. Any connection made with the water lines of the District shall be under the supervision of the Engineers for the District and shall comply with the specifications of the District and the Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C. The entire cost of such connection shall be borne by the owner or resident of the unit to be served. The tap or connection charge in each instance shall be \$60.00 for each separate residential unit, which sum includes the charge made by the Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C. The entire cost of constructing the line from the residential unit to the point of connection with the District water lines shall be borne by the owner or resident of the unit. Maintenance or repair of such connecting line shall be the sole responsibility of the owner or resident of the property. In the event repairs shall be made by the District or the Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C., in order to assure
