

on the subdivision or private water lines, the owner shall apply to the District in writing for a permit and pay the sum of \$60.00 per tap per residential unit; that the term of "residential unit" as used in this agreement, shall mean any lot or portion thereof or any number of contiguous lots used as a single residence. That in case of doubt, the ruling of the Commissioners of the District shall be final.

(e) The District's water line will be used only for the transmission of water by the Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C., to its customers and the District shall have no liability for damages resulting from any diminution or increase in the water supply or pressure.

(f) The District shall not be responsible or liable for any maintenance or repairs that may become necessary to the subdivision or private water lines and the owner agrees that in the event such maintenance or repairs may be made by the District or Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C., in order to assure the proper water supply, the owner will, upon demand, pay the entire cost thereof immediately.

(g) The owner will notify the District in writing at least ten (10) days in advance of any change or extension in the subdivision or private water lines and further agrees that in the event of the acquisition of additional adjacent land, the terms of these regulations shall automatically extend to and include any other additional subdivision or private water lines constructed in the acquired land. Any change or extension in such subdivision or private lines shall be made under the supervision of the Engineers for the District.

(h) The owner will not, or permit anyone acting for him, represent to anyone that he or they are in anywise agents for the District and such owner shall understand that he has no power or right to make promises, representations or commitments which will bind the District.

(i) The owner will abide by all of the rules, regulations, orders, by-laws and amendments thereto of the District. As used in these
