

regulations, the singular shall include the plural and the plural shall include the singular wherever applicable. This agreement shall apply with equal force where the owner is other than an individual. As used in this regulation, the term "owner" is applicable to individuals, groups of individuals, corporations or other entities, now owned or in the future constructing private or subdivision water lines.

(j) In the event of violations of any of the terms or conditions of these regulations, the District shall have the right without liability therefor to disconnect the water tap provided by the owner after ten (10) days' notice in writing addressed to the owner at his last known address.

(k) Commitments for water within the District to industrial, commercial or other large consumers shall be handled individually and made only after approval by the District and the Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C.

(l) All customers of the District shall be bound by the rules and regulations of the Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C., in accordance with the obligations of the District under its contract with such Commission of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C.

6. The effective date of these regulations shall be July 15, 1955.
