in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Harvey Cleveland, Jr., John Baker Cleveland, and Elizabeth C. Livingston, their heirs and assigns forever, an easement or right-of-way, appurtenant to the adjacent lands of the grantees, over and across that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Cleveland Township, containing 6 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land which was conveyed to the State of South Carolina by the late J. Harvey Cleveland, for use as a fish hatchery, by deed dated October 14, 1931, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 160, at page 176. The easement or right-of-way herein conveyed shall run from the Jones Gap Road to the line of the grantees' adjacent property over and along the road which now runs through the fish hatchery tract and such extension of said road as may be necessary.

This conveyance is authorized by an act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina approved on May 19, 1955, and entitled "An Act to Authorize A. A. Richardson, Chief of the Division of Game, to Grant an Easement Over Certain Property in Greenville County".
