ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of Nottingham Road near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 196, on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1951, revised through June, 1953, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.
