Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, WALTER W. GOLDSMITH in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Twenty-five & 00/100-----(\$525.00)-----DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

S. W. EVATT and GERTRUDE EVATT, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 420 of a subdivision known as Section "D", of Englewood Estates, as shown by a Plat thereof, dated February, 1955, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "BB", at Page 177.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Fairfield Road at joint front corner of Lots No. 419 and 420 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 419, S. 36-20 E. 221.8 feet to iron pin in line of Lot No. 418; thence along the line of said Lot No. 418, S. 53-40 E. 100 feet to iron pin at back line of Lot No. 423; thence along the rear line of said Lot No. 423 and along the line of Lot No. 421, N. 36-20 W. 157.6 feet to iron pin on Fairfield Road; thence running with the said Fairfield Road, S. 76-10 W. 108.3 feet to iron pin at point of beginning.

THAT the lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any negro or person of African descent; no residence to cost less than Eight Thousand Five Hundred (\$8,500.00) Dollars, shall be erected on said lots; no residence shall be erected on said lot nearer than fifty (50) feet to the front line; no residence shall be built on any lot unless said lot has fifty (50) feet, or more, frontage; no outside toilets permitted and sewage to be disposed of by approved septic tanks.

GRANTEE to pay taxes for the year 1955.

THIS deed is subject to any right-of-ways now existing.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
