THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this the 25 day of July, 1955, by and between LAURENS ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the "Cooperative", and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey, hereinafter called the "Power Company";

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, by deed dated December 21, 1954, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County South Carolina in Deed Book 514 at page 397, B. E. Greer conveyed to the Cooperative, among other things, an easement of undetermined width for a power line to be used jointly with Duke Power Company and to run from the substation lot of Cooperative to the intersection of Golden Strip Drive and U. S. Highway 276; and

WHEREAS, Florrie V. Greer individually and as executrix of the estate of B. E. Greer deceased, conveyed to Union Bay State Chemical Co., Inc., hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Chemical Company", the property shown on plat dated May 17, 1955, recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Plat Book II at page 169, being property upon which the right of way hereinabove mentioned is located; and

WHEREAS, by agreement dated July 8, 1955, by and between Union Bay State Chemical Co., Inc. and Cooperative the rights and obligations of Cooperative and of Duke Power Company under said right of way deed from B. E. Greer are set out; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to specifically set out their respective rights and obligations under and by virtue of said right of way deed from B. E. Greer:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained the parties hereto have agreed and do agree as follows:
