Lease is recorded in Deed Book 6-W at Page 187, Office of the Clerk of Court for Pickens County.

15(a) Charles D. Wyatt and Wade A. Tollison, Lessors, dated January 3, 1950, covering premises now occupied by Ballentine Grocery Stores, including store building, on the south side of Main Street and bounded on the east by Garvin Street, in the City of Pickens, for a ten-year term commencing upon the date of completion of a building which said Lessors agreed to erect on said premises, with a conditional right of refusal for an additional ten-year term.
