


No. 11 on a plat of Aberdeen Highlands, made by Falton & Hoves in November, 1941, as revised in September, 1945, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northern side of West Paris Road 92 feet East from Melville Avenue, at corner of Lot 12, and running thence with the line of said lot N. 4-43 W. 159.2 feet to a stake on a 20 foot alley; thence with the Southern side of said alley S. 73-43 E. 37.5 feet to a stake; thence continuing with said alley, S. 56-15 W. 45.3 feet to a stake at corner of lot 10; thence with the line of said lot, N. 6-05 W. 117.8 feet to a stake on West Paris Road; thence with the Northern side of said road, S. 86-32 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in Deed Book 201 at Page 446."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That at the option of Mrs. Sue H. Carlo, the owner of the last described lot, she may convey it to any assignee or any person designated by the bankrupt, free from all claims or demands of the creditors of the bankrupt.
