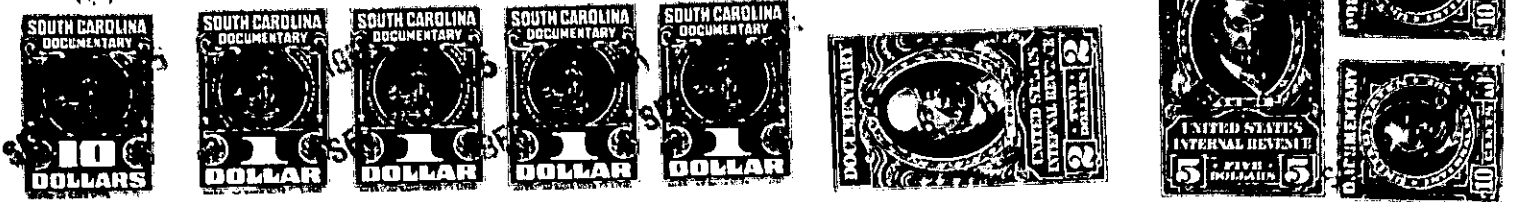

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Hazel Heard and
H. Irene Wilburn:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in _____ Township,
County, State of South Carolina , on the south side of Kenwood Lane (formerly

known as Heston Avenue), being shown as Lot No. 73 on plat of North
Park, made by Dalton & Neves, Egrs. revised February, 1941, recorded
in the R.M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "K", pages
48 and 49, and having, according to said plat, the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Kenwood Lane at joint
front corner of lots 77 and 78, said pin also being 346.7 feet East
from the southeast corner of the intersection of Kenwood Lane and
North Main Street and running thence with the line of Lot 77, S. 19-
06 W. 167.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with rear line of Lot 44,
S. 68-34 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, thence with the line of Lot 38,
N. 19-06 E. 167.5 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Kenwood
Lane, thence with the south side of Kenwood Lane, N. 68-34 W. 60 feet
to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed by Ansel Alewine
by deed dated April 11, 1946, and recorded in R. M. C. office for
Greenville County in Vol. 293, page 109.
