

CLEARANCE EAST BUT

THIS INDENTURE, made this 4th day of October,  
 1948, by and between HENRY P. WILLIAMS ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~, of Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina, and ANNIE LAURIE MCGRATH, of Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina, parties of the first part, herein referred  
 to in their hoists, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, respectively  
 to the "Hewitts", and THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and its agents, respectively  
 of the second party.

That the Grantors for and in consideration of the sum of \$1,160.  
 Sixty Two and 60/100 (\$160.60) DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
 hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the United States of America  
 and its assigns, a perpetual and assignable interest in and to the  
 following described parcel of land lying within the County of Greenville,  
 as set forth, for the approaches to the North end of the McDonald Hill  
 runway at Donaldson Air Force Base in Greenville County, State of South  
 Carolina, the or, over, across the air space above said land.

All that tract or parcel of land lying and being in  
 Greenville County, South Carolina, bounded on the north  
 east by Conestee Road and York Shoals Road, southeast  
 by the land of Elvin G. Hutchinson, southward by land of  
 the Donaldson Air Force Base, and northwest by Lot No.  
 141 of the Conestee Subdivision, all being more particularly described as follows:

No. 239 and 240 of Conestee Subdivision as shown by  
 a plat made by Madison W. Fairwater, Engineer, and recorded  
 in the R.M.C. Office in Vol. T, Page 383 and 384 of the  
 Greenville County, South Carolina Records, to the No. 239  
 and 240 having a combined acreage of 2.12 acres, more or  
 less.

The land so described is a part of the land conveyed  
 by Conestee Williams to W. M. Shelton and Henry P.  
 Williamson by deed dated July 1848 and recorded in Deed Rec.  
 255, Page 58, and interest of W. M. Shelton conveyed to  
 Henry P. Williamson by deed dated 22 November 1849 and recorded  
 in Book 307, Page 132 Register of Deeds Conveyances, Greenville  
 County, South Carolina.
