

- (b) Property known and numbered as 607-609-611 New Buncombe Road, being on the Westerly side of New Buncombe Road, commencing at a point 150 feet Northerly of the intersection of the Northerly line of Fourth Avenue and the Westerly line of New Buncombe Road and running thence S. 89-45 W. 150 feet to an alley; thence Northerly along said alley 150 feet; thence N. 89-45 E. 150 feet to the Westerly line of New Buncombe Road; thence Southerly along the Westerly line of New Buncombe Road 150 feet to the point of beginning.
