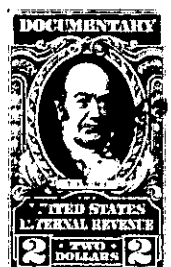
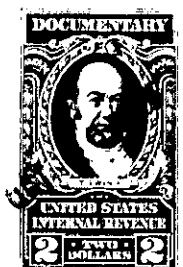

G. L. CHILES And W. C. CHILES, Their Heirs And Assigns,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of South Woodside Circle, extending to the Southern side of North Woodside Circle, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots Nos. 84 and 85 on plat of Woodside Circle, made by C. M. Furman, Engineer, March 25, 1920, recorded in plat book "E", at Page 219, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northern side of South Woodside Circle, 150 feet East from the Old Camp Road, at the corner of Lot No. 13, and running thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 13 through 18 in a Northeasterly direction 150 feet to a stake on North Woodside Circle; thence with the Southern side of North Woodside Circle, S.66-00 E. 50 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No.83; thence with line of said lot in a Southwesterly direction 150 feet to a stake on South Woodside Circle; thence with the Northern side of South Woodside Circle, N.66-00 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner; this being the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed of Irene Y. Long by deed dated November 6, 1946, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 304, at Page 103.

ALSO, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of South Woodside Circle and the Southern side of North Woodside Circle, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots 82 and 83 on plat of Woodside Circle, made by C. M. Furman, Engineer, March 25, 1920, recorded in Plat Book "E", at Page 219, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northern side of South Woodside Circle, 200 feet East from the Old Camp Road, at corner of Lot No. 84, and running thence with line of said lot in a Northeasterly direction 150 feet to stake on North Woodside Circle; thence with the Southern side of North Woodside Circle, S.66-00 E. 50 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No.81; thence with line of said lot in a Southwesterly direction 150 feet to a stake on South
