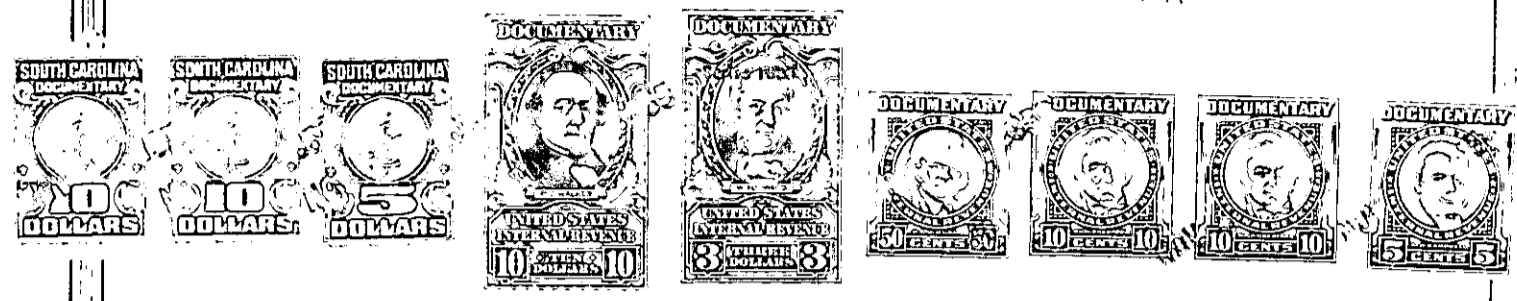

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L.A. Nelson, Edwin McT. Meares, S.L. McCleskey, E. G. Sumney, J. W. Copeland and T. M. McNeill, Trustees of Trinity Methodist Church (formerly Memorial Methodist Church)

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of -----  
Twelve thousand Five Hundred (\$12,500.00)----- Dollars  
to US ----- in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by ----- Isobel Lane Sisk -----

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Isobel Lane Sisk, her heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the west side of West Paris Road and being a portion of Lot No. 6 and a portion of Lot No. 5 of the property of John T. Davenport on unrecorded plat drawn by R. E. Bolton, Engineer, March, 1924 and being more particularly shown on a revision of said plat drawn by Piedmont Engineering Service for Memorial Methodist Church (now Trinity Methodist Church) on July 23, 1948, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the west side of West Paris Road in the line of Lot No. 5, according to the John T. Davenport plat hereinabove referred to, said pin being 360.6 feet from the south side of the Augusta Road, and running thence N. 69-0 W. 180.6 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 5 of the Davenport plat hereinabove referred to; thence S. 21-23 W. 70 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 6 on said Davenport plat at the joint rear corner of property herein conveyed and property heretofore conveyed by grantors to T. M. McNeill (See Deed Book 369, page 113, office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County); thence along the line of property of T. M. McNeill, S. 69-0 E. 181.1 feet to an iron pin on the west side of West Paris Road in the line of Lot No. 6 as shown on said Davenport plat, joint front corner of property herein conveyed and property of T. M. McNeill; thence along the west side of West Paris Road, N. 21-00 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the remaining portion of the property heretofore conveyed to the Trustees of Memorial Methodist Church by John T. Davenport by deed dated August 23, 1948, recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 359, page 359, less that portion heretofore conveyed by the grantors as Trustees of Trinity Methodist Church (formerly Memorial Methodist Church) to T. M. McNeill by deed dated November 11, 1948 and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 369, page 113. The name of Memorial Methodist Church was formally changed to Trinity Methodist
