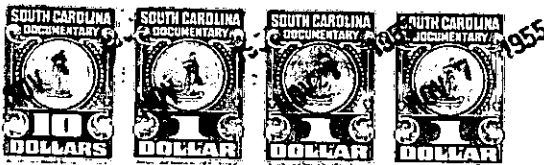

Know All Men by These Presents:

That We, James N. West and Dorothy M. West in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred and No/100--(6,500.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. C. Cook, his heirs or assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on public road leading from Simpsonville to Fountain Inn, one mile east from the Town of Simpsonville, containing 28.41 acres, more or less according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor in March 1925, and being more fully described as follows;

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of two public roads, corner of lands of M. E. Jones and running thence along the road S. 11 W. 2.98 chains to an iron pin, corner of L. P. Goodwin land; thence with the Goodwin line, S. 75¼ W. 12.90 chains to a rock, corner of J. R. Burdett lands; thence with Burdett line S. 58½ W. 8.50 chains to a road, corner of D. W. Burdett lands; thence with Burdett line N. 85 ¾ W. 7 chains to a rock, corner of W. M. Fowler lands; thence with Fowler line N. 3 E. 16.80 chains to an iron pin in public road, corner of Vance Balcome land; thence along Balcome line and a road in an easterly direction to an iron pin, corner of lands of M. E. Jones, and the point of beginning.

The Above described tract is the same conveyed to James N. West and Dorothy M. West by P. B. Fincher by deed dated October 20, 1952 and recorded in Vol. 465 at page 281 in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office.
