in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Richard P. Norris and Edna D. Norris, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number 1 of the Property of W. T. Patrick and W. R. Timmons, Jr., according to a plat of record in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book II at page 93, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern side of Lowndes Hill Road at the joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2, and running thence S. 13-30 E. 166.6 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence S. 76-30 W. 80 feet to a point on the Eastern side of Oakland Drive at the rear corner of Lot 1; thence with the Eastern side of Oakland Drive, N. 13-30 W. 130 feet to a point; thence following the curvature of the Southeastern intersection of Oakland Drive with Lowndes Hill Road (the chord of which is N. 25-32 E. 31.1 feet) to a point; thence with the Southern side of Lowndes Hill Road, N. 64-34 E. 61.8 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by William R. Timmons, Jr. and W. T. Patrick by deed dated June 28, 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 529, page 384.
