to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. R. Bishop, and Margaret Emma Bishop, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate and located in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Pine Street, known and designated as lot No. Twenty-Six (26) in a sub-division known as "Nicktown Heights" No. 2, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "M" at page 5, and according to said plat is described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Pine Street at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 25 and 26 and running thence with Pine Street, S-34-0-E, 40 feet to joint front corner lot Nos. 26 and 27; thence S-56-0-W, 120 feet to joint rear corner of lots Nos. 26 and 27; thence with joint line of lots Nos. 26 and 38, N-34-0-E, 40 feet to joint rear corner of lots Nos. 25 and 26; thence N-56-0-E, 120 feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to the grantor herein by John Shell Ashmore by deed dated July 27, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 505, page 2.
