WHEREAS, Joe Carman and Doris Day, ^{R.M.C.} unwedded, are the parents of a ~~girl~~ ^{boy} child, born in the Maternity Shelter, Greenville, S. C., on November 19th, 1955, and to which child was given the name of Blain Kenneth Day; and

WHEREAS, the said parents have decided to grant and deed the said child to K. S. Owens and Frances Owens, husband and wife, until the said child reaches the age of twenty-one years of age, with rights of inheritance in and to the said child from said adopting parents; and

WHEREAS, the said adopting parents have agreed to and consented to take and adopt the said child, giving to it the full rights of inheritance as though it were their own flesh and blood child, and which adoption appears to all of said parties to be for the decided best interest of the said child; now, therefore, it is stipulated: That the said X Joe Carman and Doris Day, natural parents of the said Blain Kenneth Day, do now, in consideration of the said adoption and agreement on the part of the adopting parents, grant, give, transfer, adopt to and surrender the said child unto the care, custody, and control of the said K. S. Owens and Frances Owens, upon the understanding and agreement that the said adopting parents will give to the said child the best care, attentions, support, maintenance, education and raising possible within their means and ability; and also that the said child be given full rights of inheritance by said adopting parents; and said natural parents agree not to interfere with, molest or hinder said adopting parents in any wise in such care and rearing of said child, nor will the said parents permit any such to be done by third parties so long as within their power to prevent.

It is further stipulated and agreed that the name of the said child may be changed to that of Blain Kenneth Owens, and by which name it shall be known and called; and correction of the birth certificate of the said child to be changed when so desired.
