All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Green-ville County, State of South Carolina, and located three (3) miles north of Tigerville, being bounded by lands of Grady Howard, Laurence Gosnell, Saluda Land Co., John Howard and George Odom, and being the same property that was conveyed by deed from John H. Heath, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 345 at page 167, and having been estimated as two and one-half acres, more or less, but by a survey of same by H. S.
