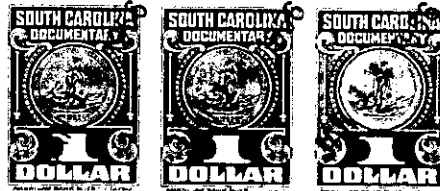

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Stella Mae Atkins, in her own right and as Executrix of the
Estate of B. C. Atkins; T. E. Atkins, et al

on or about the 8th day of November in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and Fifty Five exhibited their
complaint in the County Court for the County aforesaid, against Broadus Atkins,
Carl Atkins, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 23rd day of December 1955,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged

of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$1200.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents. DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said E. Beaufort Crain, Jr. the following described real estate:

All of that parcel or tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township of
Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on both sides of a road leading
from Gowansville to Glassy Mountain and containing 26 acres, more or less,
having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a stone, old
D. R. Evans corner, and runs thence S. 15 1/4 W. 5.00 chains to a stone in
old road; thence with old road N. 54 W. 7.30 chains to a stake in road
opposite three oaks; thence S. 11 W. 4.84 chains to a stone; thence S.
57 1/2 E. 20.15 chains to a stake in said Glassy Mountain Road; thence with
said road S. 41 E. 2.56 chains to an iron pin in said road; thence N. 41 E.
21.40 chains to a stone in woods near head of branch on line of the Bowden
land; thence S. 78.05 W. 14.16 chains to a stone near a spring; thence
N. 66.45 W. 8.00 chains to a stone in old road bed; thence N. 63 1/2 W. 3.60
chains to the beginning, bounded by lands now or formerly owned by D. R.
