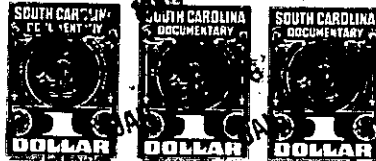

Know All Men by These Presents:

That we, Lide L. Richbourg and Lila M. Richbourg in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED & NO/100 (\$1,400.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

JAMES W. GILBERT:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot Number Forty-Four (44), as shown on plat of property of Morningside, as made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in December 1952, which plat is of record in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in "lat Book "FF", at pages 83, 84 and 85 reference to which plat is hereby made, said lot of land being described by metes and bounds, as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Clearview Avenue as shown on said plat at the corner common to Lots 43 and 44, and running thence North 35-45 East along the dividing line between Lots 43 and 44, one hundred eighty (180.0) feet to an iron pin; thence South 54-15 East along the dividing line of James Edwards property, one hundred twenty-five (125.0) feet to an iron pin at the corner common to Lots 44 and 45; thence South 35-45 West along the dividing line between Lots 44 and 45, one hundred eighty (180.0) feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Clearview Avenue; thence continuing along said Clearview Avenue North 54-15 West one hundred twenty-five (125.0) feet to the place of beginning.

This property is subject to the restrictions and reservations set out in an instrument of writing dated January 20, 1953, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Deed Book 470 at page 369, reference to which is hereby expressly made as a part of this conveyance, and is subject to the following additional restriction: "All tanks, barrels, and containers for fuel oil shall be placed below the surface of the ground or concealed".

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and His Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
