DURHAM and KATHERINE C. DURHAM, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 22 of a subdivision known as Section "C", of Englewood Estates, as shown by a Plat thereof, dated December, 1951, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book, "B", at Page 13.

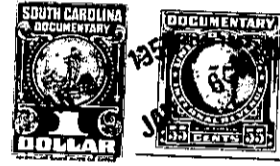

THIS deed is made subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. No house is to be erected costing less than Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars.
2. No house is to be built closer than fifty (50) feet to the street.
3. No temporary house is to be erected on said lot.

THIS deed is subject to any rights-of-way now existing.
