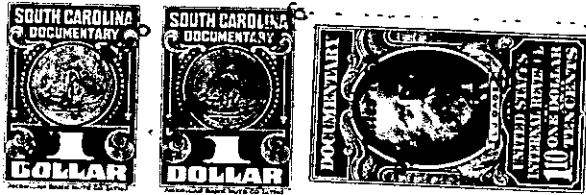

by Toxie L. Price and Callie Mae Price
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Toxie L. Price and Callie Mae Price
their heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, lying and situated in Grove Station School Dis-
trict 4c, adjoining land of Julian Wilson and estate of S. M. Jones, lying
between Piedmont & Northern Railway and Highway number 29, having
the following courses and distances to wit; -

BEGINNING at iron pin corner of Julian Wilson line thence down Highway
number 29 S-43- W 86 feet 7 inches to iron pin corner S. M. Jones estate
lot, thence along line of the S. M. Jones estate property 521 feet, 4 inches
to iron pin bank of P & N Railway, thence along line of P & N Ry 91 feet
7 inches to iron pin corner of Julian Wilson line, thence N-48-1/2
W- 510 feet along line of Julian Wilson property to the beginning corner.
