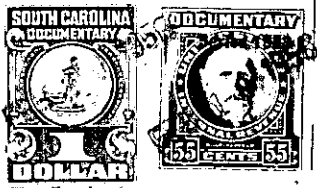

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Julius I. O. Shields

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville,
County, State of South Carolina Being the same conveyed to me by deed from S. M.
Goldsmith, and having the following metes and bounds to wit, Beginning at a
stake in branch at the right of way of the G& N. Rail Road, thence down said
branch 865 to a willow now gone, at the fork of said branch, thence N.
22¹/₂ E. 1900. to a stone, thence S. 65. W. 720. to a stake, on right of way, for said
Rail Road, 105 0 to the beginning corner. And containing seventeen and one
fourth Acres, more or less.
