Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Homer Styles, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-seven & 66/100- - DOLLARS, in the State aforesaid,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James W. Clark, B. E. McAlister and W. C. Taylor, their heirs and assigns: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, with all improvements thereon, containing 21.50 acres, as shown by plat thereof prepared by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, December 13, 1941, and thereon described as follows:

BEGINNING at poplar 3XOM on line of F. G. Moore, southwestern corner of this tract, and runs thence with the Moore line N. 18-30 W. 847 feet to a stake; thence N. 20-30 E. 1340 feet to iron pin on the northwestern side of road; thence along in and/or near said road S. 53-30 E. 88.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 51-00 E. 225 feet; thence S. 53-18 E. 224.5 feet to a stake, cornering with Alice Dempsey; thence with that line N. 30-00 E. 625 feet to stake and large poplar O M; thence S. 62-45 E. 184 feet to a stake; thence S. 23-00 W. 303.6 feet to a stake; thence S. 46-20 W. 79 feet to a stake; thence S. 25-20 W. 221 feet to a stake; thence S. 23-20 W. 208 feet to a stake; thence S. 46-35 W. 227.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 62-35 W. 105.6 feet to a stake; thence S. 55-05 W. 132 feet; thence S. 26-35 W. 198 feet; thence S. 9-05 W. 137 feet; thence S. 4-35 W. 911 feet to a fence post (last ten courses and distances being along/or/and near branch); thence S. 88-40 W. 153 feet to the beginning corner, and bounded north and northeast by Alice Dempsey; east by lands of Carl Styles; south by G. Manos, and southwest and west by lands of P. G. Moore, less 2 acres sold to Carl Styles 9/22/54, recorded in Deed Book 509, page 305.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

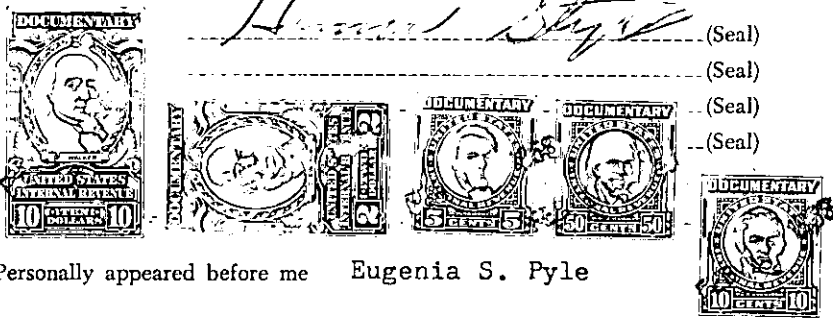
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.
