

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA :  
COUNTY OF GREENVILLE : POWER OF ATTORNEY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Grace Holbrook, of Greenville County, South Carolina, being Twenty One (21) years of age, untrained in business affairs, physically disabled and desiring to carry out the wishes of my deceased father, William E. Holbrook, as expressed in his last Will and Testament, do hereby name constitute and appoint my brother, Laurie P. Holbrook, of Greenville County, South Carolina, my true and lawful Attorney in Fact, for me and in my name and stead:

To have and to exercise full and complete charge, management and control of all my moneys and all my property and property rights and interests, of whatsoever kind and wheresoever the same may be, and especially all of such as is bequeathed and devised to me in and by the said last Will and Testament of my deceased father, and as to all to which I may be legally entitled to receive under and by the terms and provisions thereof, and as and when same may be payable.

To have and to exercise full and complete charge, management and control of my finances and of any and all banking and/or savings account or accounts which I carry or may hereafter carry, in any financial or banking institution or in the U. S. Postoffice; to deposit in my name and for my account any check or checks which may come into his hands as such Attorney in Fact, as well as to any and all moneys and otherwise payable to or belonging to me; and for that purpose to sign my name and endorse same for deposit or collection; and from time to time, to withdraw any and/or all moneys so deposited in such depositories and for that purpose to draw checks in my name.

In his discretion, to place any of my moneys and funds so as to draw interest at the rate prevailing, depending where placed.

To ask, demand, sue for, levy, collect, recover and receive any and all moneys, claims, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues, accounts, and other demands, which are or shall be due, owing, and/or payable to me or detained from me; and to give and execute therefor, proper and sufficient receipts, acquittances and discharges.

To pay any and all my just and legal debts, claims, demands, accounts, dues or liabilities of any nature, which are, or shall be, owing and/or payable by me; and to receive and accept therefor, proper and sufficient receipts, acquittances and discharges.

To contract, make, execute, sign and deliver, and to accept and receive, any and all contracts, documents and written instruments as may be necessary, proper and legal to effect the foregoing and to preserve and protect my rights and interests.

To make any necessary, proper and legal adjustment or compromise.

To pay any and all costs, charges and expenses, as may be necessary proper and legal, out of my said funds.

To keep a true and accurate account and record of any and all transactions; receipts and disbursements, and to render me a proper accounting, when and as I may require same to be made.

Giving and granting unto my said Attorney in Fact, by these presents, full power and authority in and about the premises, and authorizing him to do and perform all necessary acts in the execution of the foregoing; and I do expressly declare that the powers herein granted to him, shall not be construed as limited to those matters hereinbefore specifically mentioned, but rather shall be construed to broadly include and embrace full and unlimited power and authority to do and perform on my behalf and in my place and stead and with equal validity, any and all other lawful acts or things which I could do if personally present; hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever he shall and may do by virtue hereof in the premises.
