All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and known as tract No. 1 of the division of the estate of S. K. White, deceased, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

"Beginning at stone 3X in road and running N. 6 3/4 E. 11.50 to a stone 3X in road; thence N. 7 1/2 W. 40.75 to stake in branch by stump; thence along branch S. 38 W. 20.50 to turn; thence S. 04 W. 3.00 to turn S. 59 W. 10.00 to turn S. 16 1/2 W. 2.50; thence S. 03 1/2 E. 4.00 to turn S. 23 W. 2.50 to stake in branch; thence S. 10 1/4 E. 14.50 to stone 3X thence N. 76 3/4 E. 3.12 to stone 3A; thence S. 72 E. 26.25 to beginning and containing (100 acres) more or less and further described as adjoining lands of W.
