in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eugene E. Stone, Jr., A. M. Stone, Ann S. Cleveland, and Hallie S. Maxon, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the northwestern side of U. S. Highway No. 29, known as the Super Highway, and having, according to a plat prepared by J. C. Hill, L. S., February 21, 1956, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northern corner of the intersection of U. S. Highway No. 29 with Cary Street, and running thence along the northwestern edge of U. S. Highway No. 29, N. 45-45 E. 268.1 feet to a point in a branch; thence up the meanders of said branch as the line, the traverse lines of which are N. 66 W. 47 feet, N. 42 W. 144 feet, N. 54 E. 50 feet, N. 23 W. 65 feet, N. 39 W. 113.5 feet, and S. 87 W. 79 feet to an iron pin on the eastern edge of Mohawk Drive; thence along the eastern edge of Mohawk Drive, S. 6-40 W. 335.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the eastern edge of Mohawk Drive, S. 10 W. 131.6 feet to an iron pin at the northeastern corner of the intersection of Mohawk Drive with Cary Street; thence along the northern edge of Cary Street, S. 71-10 E. 125.8 feet to the beginning corner.
