in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Fifty and No/100 - - - - - DOLLARS,

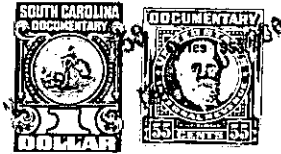
