Know All Men by These Presents:

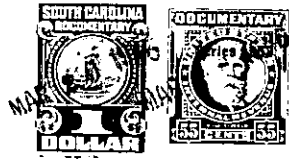

C., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 13, Section 2, of a subdivision known as Lazy City, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C.
