That I, L. R. Floyd, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Ten and No/100 DOLLARS,

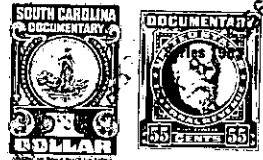
