WHEREAS, On or about April 29, 1954, certain Protective Covenants were imposed upon certain property shown as Tract 1 on plat of property of McAlister Estate prepared by C. C. Jones, Engineer, July, 1953, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB at pages 46 and 47; and

WHEREAS, By reason of the suitability of portions of said land fronting on both sides of Pleasantburg Boulevard for retail and other commercial uses, it is necessary to provide for driveways, curb-cuts or entrances closer together than 200 feet; and

WHEREAS, All of the owners of property within Tract 1 on said plat have consented to this amendment and the same is approved and accepted by the Greenville City Planning & Zoning Commission,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED That Paragraph 9 of said Protective Covenants is amended to read as follows:

"(9) On both sides of Pleasantburg Boulevard there shall be no driveways, curb-cuts or entrances onto the right-of-way of said Pleasantburg Boulevard closer than 100 feet to one another on center; provided, however, the owner of any lot fronting not less than 100 feet on Pleasantburg Boulevard shall have the right to make and use a driveway, curb-cut or entrance for access to said lot. Said curbcuts or entrances shall in no event exceed 48 feet in width, and the use of the areas between said curb-cuts or entrances for ingress and egress shall be prohibited by the owner or owners of said property by the maintenance of a barrier along the front lot line at the time that the property is developed.
