WHEREAS, The above entitled action was instituted by summons, complaint and rule to show cause dated February 11, 1956, in which action plaintiffs alleged that the defendants were trespassing upon plaintiffs' property and sought a permanent restraining order against the defendants.

By deed dated August 10, 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 439 at page 483, the plaintiff, Maggie L. Gilreath, conveyed to the plaintiff, Lura May Turner, reserving unto herself a life estate, a certain tract of land in O'Neal Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining property of the defendants, in which deed the dividing line between plaintiffs and defendants is referred to as "S. 7 1/2 W." The property of the defendants, adjoining plaintiffs' property, was conveyed to them by Mamie P. Dickens, et al, by deed dated March 12, 1954, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 495 at page 498, in which deed said dividing line is referred to as "S. 6 1/2 W."

Shortly after the service of the above entitled proceeding upon the defendants, said defendants obtained counsel and by agreement of all parties the dividing line between said properties was run by J. C. Hill, L.S., and platted by him by plat dated April 6, 1956, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Plat Book J.J. at page 187, said dividing line as run by J. C. Hill having the course "N. 8-35 E."
