Ducker shall own and possess the said real estate free and clear of any restrictions whatsoever or which may have been imposed thereon by them.

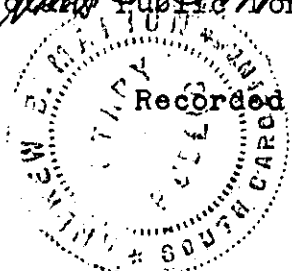
