Lumber Company, Inc.,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot #30, of a subdivision known as North Gardens, Section 2, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, page 103, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at joint front corner of lots #29 and #30, running thence along the line of said lots, S. 79-0 W. 161.4 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 10-27 W. 53.8 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of lots #30 and #1, thence along the line of these lots, N. 84-15 W. 155.7 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Azalea Court, thence along Azalea Court, which line is curved, the chord of which is S. 1-55 W. 57.8 feet to a concrete monument, thence continuing along Azalea Court S. 11-00 E. 42.2 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.
