in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) and payment of debts set out below ~~DOLLARS~~,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Inez Bates, her heirs and assigns forever,

ALL MY UNDIVIDED INTEREST IN AND TO:

"All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at the Northwestern corner of Gallivan Avenue and Bennett Street, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 60 on plat of North Hills, recorded in Plat Book H at Page 138, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake at the Northwestern corner of Gallivan Avenue and Bennett Street, and running thence with the Northern side of Gallivan Avenue, N. 71-43 W. 71 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 59; thence with the line of said lot, N. 19-17 E. 170 feet to a stake on a 20-foot alley; thence with the Southern side of said alley, S. 71-43 E. 71 feet to a stake on Bennett Street; thence with the western side of Bennett Street, S. 19-17 W. 170 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to Inez Bates and Gertrude Johnston by Kathryn H. As a part of the consideration of this deed the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the debts of the Estate of Gertrude Johnston aggregating approximately \$7700.00.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
